

## RECOMMENDED BARREL LENGTHS

If your barrel is not listed here, please ask. The measurement needs to be taken from the breech face (usually there is a gas escape hole nearby) to the end of the muzzle.

<b>Standard Weight Overbarrel Suppressor</b> 500grams and sits 5" forward of muzzle & 8" back Our aim is to halve recoil and remove 2/3rds of the bang		<b>Lightweight Overbarrel Suppressor</b> 400 grams sits 5" forward of muzzle & 7" back Our aim is to halve recoil and remove 2/3rds of the bang
